



## State of Ohio Out-Of-School Suspension Data

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Restorative Practices have been proven to be effective after the incident allowing the student to: (1) understand what they did wrong, (2) how it affected others, and (3) how they can correct the behavior moving forward. School suspensions whether in-school or out-of-school DO NOT MODIFY BEHAVIOR unless there is an intervention that takes place during the process!

- Note:
- (1) These are the top six (6) out of 14 discipline occurrences, that resulted in Out-of-School Suspensions.
  - (2) \*Disobedient/Disruptive Behavior is *subjective*. It is the highest category for both years in all areas of discipline from out-of-school, in-school suspensions, emergency removal by district, expulsions, etc.
